Please take a moment to read this notice about the filming of a docudrama tv series entitled “Disasters At Sea” at the **Port Dover Pier and Beach Area , on October 10, 2018**. We would like to provide information to help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our activity might affect your daily routine.

We will be filming exterior scenes between the hours of **11am-2am**. We will be parking our production vehicles in some of the parking spaces at the end of Harbour St. We will not be taking up all the space there and there will be spots open to the public. We are **not** requesting a beach or pier closure of any kind and everything will remain open to the public.

There will be **NO** special effects, gunfire, drones, pyrotechnics or road closures. Lights we will be using are LED lights and should not throw off enough bright light to cause a disruption. At 10pm we will be setting a larger light from the beach area, but the light will be directed towards the water and should not affect residents or businesses.

Our goal is a quick set-up and tear-down to minimize our time in the area. We are aware of the inconvenience caused by our activity and apologize in advance. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated and if you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me at 905-807-5532.
